Dear Parents and Carers

RE: Post 16 Information Session for Parents, Carers and Pupils.

I hope this letter finds you and your families well and safe during this second period of National Lockdown. Importantly schools remain open this time and I am really pleased that attendance from year 11 continues to be high. Pupils are taking their studies seriously, working hard in lessons, equally as hard in after school intervention and independent study sessions and most pupils are embedding their learning at home through regular revision and homework. As you know pupils are currently preparing for their first round of year 11 mock exams that begin on Monday 7th December. We are currently awaiting more information from the government regarding the plans for GCSE 2021 summer series but at the moment all we know is that GCSEs will go ahead as planned but have been pushed back several weeks and will not finish until the start of July. This will give us a couple of extra weeks to help pupils with their preparation.

It's a busy time for pupils as they also have Post 16 destinations to consider and apply for – this is a big decision and it is not easy to navigate through all the information available. Normally to support you, you would have attended a face to face year 11 evening in October, received your child's predicted grade report, listened to a presentation from SMA staff and talked to post 16 providers in a market style event. You would also have also had opportunities to visit post 16 schools, academies and colleges and been able to speak to advisors and teachers about possible courses and subjects to study. I'm really pleased that many pupils have already attended virtual events and some have already made applications and are awaiting interviews.

In addition to the virtual events provided by providers we are organising a number Post -16 information virtual events for SMA pupils and parents. These will take place on Thursday 26th November at 5.30pm. Each event will have a clear focus, pupils and parents will be expected to sign up in advance (by 12pm, Tuesday 23rd November) and will be able to send questions prior to the sessions. Each virtual event will be hosted by 2 members of staff, be no longer than 45mins and there will be an opportunity for a live Q & A. Pupils must be accompanied by a parent, log in via their SMA email address and must remain visible throughout the session.

Session C A Level & Level 3 Creative & performing arts and sport
