In order to apply for our Media & Communication Scholarship Programme you should demonstrate ALL or MOST of these skills and attributes:

- \Rightarrow A natural flair for English
- \Rightarrow Articulate and confident speaker
- \Rightarrow A reading age that is higher than actual age
- \Rightarrow Excellent spelling, punctuation and grammar skills
- \Rightarrow Be a deep, critical thinker particularly around context of texts/topics
- \Rightarrow Perceptive analysis skills and the ability to interpret meaning
- \Rightarrow Ability to write for a purpose and audience
- \Rightarrow Have a wider cultural understanding and interest in social, political, historical context
- \Rightarrow Focused, ambitious and resilient to feedback

What does the Scholarship mean for me?

Once potential scholars have a confirmed place at our academy from the relevant local authority, pupils will be invited in for an audition later in the year to secure their place on the scholarship programme.

Pupils will need to sign up with the Admissions Officer to confirm their attendance.

Each applicant should prepare a 2 minute speech to deliver during the audition outlining the reasons why they are a suitable candidate for the scholarship. They will also participate in a live debate and work in a small groups to create a short film.
