

## Humanities – Fairtrade

Children will:

- Study the history of trading, including links to Ancient Egypt studied last term.
- Look at the creation of Fairtrade in 1992, including locations and distribution of profits.
- Make comparisons between trade and Fairtrade, looking at the advantages and disadvantages of both.

## English

Children will cover the following topics:

- Internal monologue
- Narratives

Focusing on grammatical aspects of language as well as composition and effect.

## Maths

Children will be taught to:

- Multiply and divide by 10 and 100
- Use formal multiplication methods for two and three digit numbers by one digit numbers.
- Measure length and perimeter
- Express fractions as part of a whole

There will also be an ongoing focus on the multiplication tables up to 12x12

## RE – Jesus the Teacher

Children will learn about Jesus' role on Earth as a teacher. They will look at his teaching in the temple, his Baptism, his disciples and the parables.

## PSHE – Dreams and Goals

Children will explore; their aspirations, how to achieve their goals and understanding the emotions that go with this.

Children will:

Explore and investigate biscuits – thinking about recipes, preferences and packaging.

Children will continue to learn and become more fluent in Spanish using;

Children will learn about how to:

- Construct and interpret a variety of food chains.
